These newsletters are sent on a monthly basis, and the next one is due to be sent out around December 4th.





What got my attention on this one is that although it was named a hospital, the details of the schedule read more like a school.

According to <u>Wikipedia</u>, Colston's Hospital was founded in 1710 by Edward Colston, merchant, member of parliament, philanthropist, and slave trader as an all boys boarding school. Name remained unchanged until 1991 when it merged with a nearby girls school, and became Colston's Collegiate School. The name changed further in 2022 to just Collegiate School in order to drop references to the slave trader who started the school.
