These newsletters are sent on a monthly basis, and the next one is due to be sent out around December 4th.

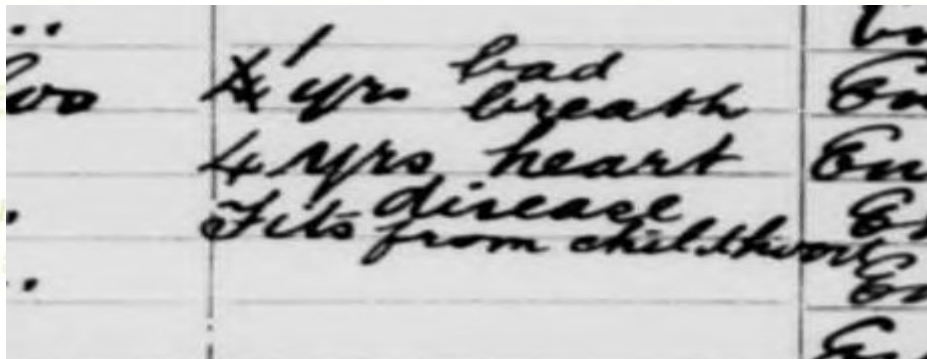

(From Sarah Smart)

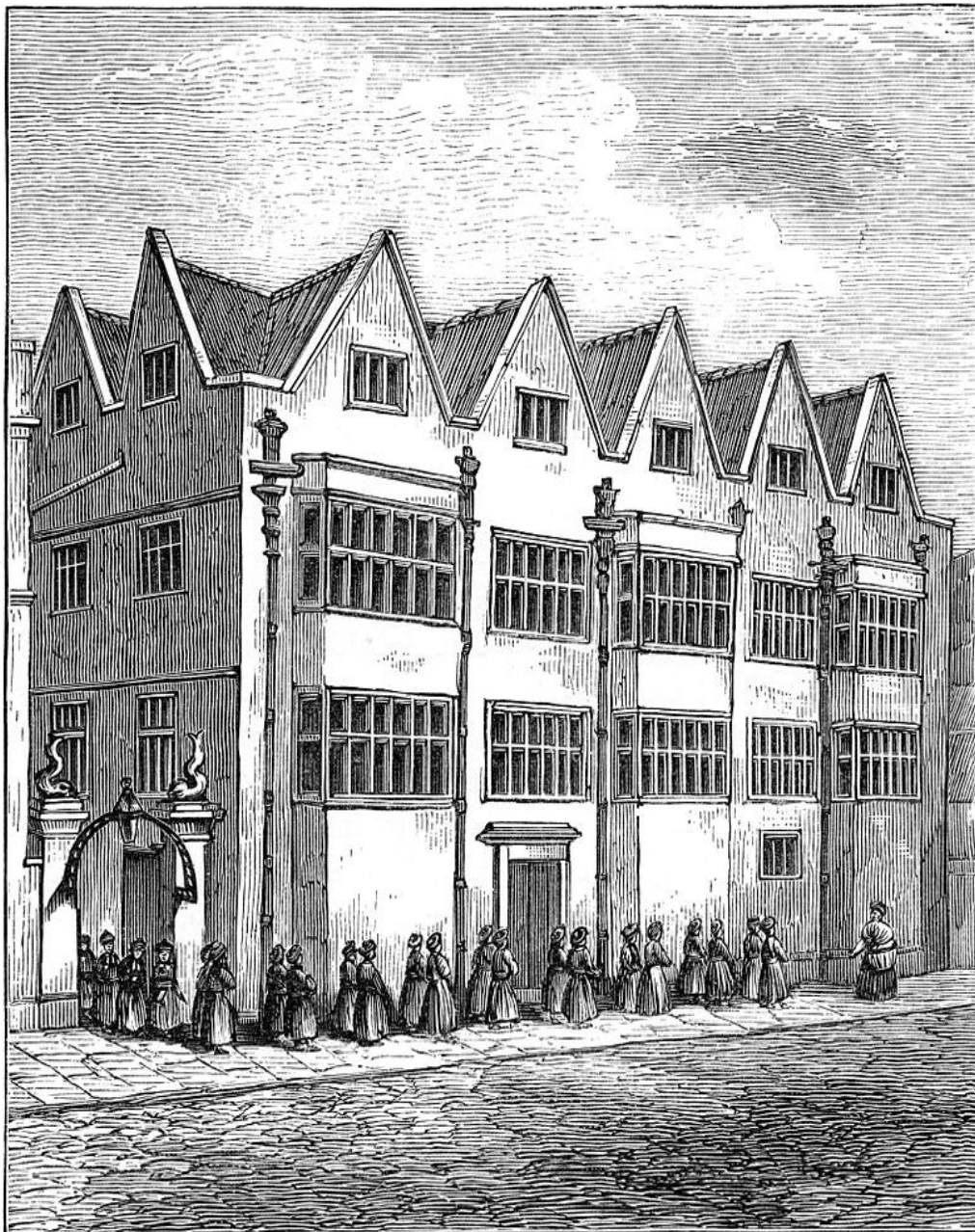
Found while doing the proofread of Gloucester 1851 piece HO107\_314, an entry for Colston's Hospital with 108 in residences, a good sample of why it may sometimes be useful, and interesting in researching such institutions, especially if you have a person of interest staying there.

What got my attention on this one is that although it was named a hospital, the details of the schedule read more like a school.

According to [Wikipedia](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Colston%27s_Hospital), Colston's Hospital was founded in 1710 by Edward Colston, merchant, member of parliament, philanthropist, and slave trader as an all boys boarding school. Name remained unchanged until 1991 when it merged with a nearby girls school, and became Colston's Collegiate School. The name changed further in 2022 to just Collegiate School in order to drop references to the slave trader who started the school.

#### Important Notes:

- If the piece number has a letter after it, then this suggests that the upload only contains particular districts within the piece, not all districts that make up the piece
- If a place name is followed by a county code, then this indicates that this place is actually in that county, not the county the piece is listed under
