## Places that Still Exists



## Pensioner at Age 21 (from Chris Mahoney)

During the validation of an 1851 Nottingham piece I came across one Henry CLARK, aged 21, and with an enumerated occupation of Pensioner.

How this person became a pensioner at such a young age in 1851 is anyone's guess, could even been wrong. Anyway, Henry was easy enough to track down in later years, and for the 1861 census, an occupation of FWK (abbreviated from Frame Work Knitter) was enumerated for him.



## Enumerator's Copying of Pages

Anyone who is familiar with the 1841 census will be guite familiar with seeing pages that have had portions crossed out, and a question that has been asked on a number of occasions, what should one do with those entries that have been crossed out.

Below is such a sample of a page partially crossed out from Flintshire 1841 piece HO107 1409.



My response is that it usually means that the entries have been copied to somewhere else in the same piece by the enumerator, and sometimes, the enumerator may even say where they have been copied to as with the above sample.

However, do not take the enumerator's word for it. Do check and obtain visual confirmation for yourself that the entries are indeed enumerated elsewhere. If in doubt, transcribe the crossed out section anyway, better to have the entries transcribed twice rather than not at all.

In the case of our sample, the enumerator's comments on where the entries have been copied to are correct, and here is the duplicated section from the same piece on where the crossed out entries were copied to.

Now compare the two versions of these entries, and we get a visual confirmation that enumerators were known for not always getting things correct as it is clear they have made alterations, and omitted details.

My advice to the proofreader was to go with the version not crossed out, but add the details from the crossed out section with a note to say where the added information came from.

### Important Notes:

- If the piece number has a letter after it, then this suggests that the upload only contains particular districts within the piece, not all districts that make up the piece
- If a place name is followed by a county code, then this indicates that this place is actually in that county, not the county the piece is listed under
